City of Healdsburg Holds Public Meeting to Solicit Input on Healdsburg Avenue Bridge Project

The City of Healdsburg is holding a public meeting Wednesday, March 31st at the Healdsburg Senior Center to solicit input on either rehabilitating or replacing the Healdsburg Avenue Bridge.

Improvements to or replacement of the steel truss bridge have been prompted by concerns about the structure's seismic stability, ability to handle growing traffic flow, and its ability to withstand flood waters.

The City is seeking public input at this meeting to aid in developing alternatives to be considered for this project.
