The City Invites Public to Attend a Public Open House to Learn About Preliminary Concepts For Healdsburg Bridge

Preliminary concepts for the Healdsburg Avenue Bridge project, developed by the City's engineering consultant Omni-Means, will be presented to the public at an April 29 public open house in Healdsburg.

Since the last open house on March 31 of this year, Omni-Means has been developing concepts for the bridge project. Public feedback from the March open house helped shape the preliminary concepts, which will be presented at an open house to be held on Thursday, April 29 at the Healdsburg Senior Center, located at 133 Matheson Street in Healdsburg from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m.

Staff from the City and the Omni-Means team will be on hand to answer questions about the project concepts developed from input by the public, the City, and project stakeholders. The process for developing the concepts and what the next steps are in the Healdsburg Avenue Bridge project will be addressed, as well.

The next public meeting for the project will be held on May 11 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall to receive public comment on the concepts presented at the April 29 open house.
