City Council to Receive Recommendation of Preferred Alternative for Continued Environmental Studies for the Healdsburg Avenue Bridge Project

On September 7 City staff and the Omni-Means team will make a presentation to the Healdsburg City Council about their findings related to the Healdsburg Avenue Bridge project and will recommend a preferred alternative for the next phase of environmental review. All interested parties are invited to attend.

A select few additional alternatives, for purposes of completing the remaining technical and environmental reviews and studies on the project, will also be recommended to the Council. The technical and environmental reviews are required under state and federal regulations.

Where: City Hall, 401 Grove Street, Healdsburg, City Council Chambers

Time: Presentation to begin no sooner than 6:00 P.M.

To date, the City has held five open houses and/or public meetings to solicit public input that was considered by the Omni-Means team as part of the Concept Analysis Process used to select a range of project alternatives. The Omni-Means team considered and evaluated factors related to safety; pedestrian and bicycle access; traffic flow; public transportation; right-of-way needs; and impacts on the historic significance of the bridge, biological resources, and the Veterans Memorial Park.
